Ms. Tao received a bachelor's degree in textile engineering from China Textile University (中國紡織大學) (currently known as Donghua University (東華大學)) of the PRC in January 1982 and a doctorate degree in textile physics from University of New South Wales in August 1987. From September 1987 to September 1988 and from October 1990 to September 1994, she had been a scientist of the Commonwealth Scientific and Industrial Research Organisation of Australia. From October 1988 to January 1990, she had been a lecturer of Donghua University. Ms. Tao was the recipient of two prestigious individual awards of the field: the honorary fellowship by The Textile Institute in November 2010 and the founder award of the Fiber Society of the United States in November 2013. With five academic monographs, over 600 research papers published and over 20 patents granted, she

has been internationally recognised in particular for her pioneering work on smart textiles and clothing and textile engineering such as low-twist yarns, solospun yarns and fabric sensing technology which have been widely applied in the textile industry.

In the last three years immediately preceding the date of this announcement, Ms. Tao did not hold any directorship in any public companies the securities of which are listed on any securities market in Hong Kong or overseas.

Ms. Tao has entered into an appointment letter with the Company for a term of one year commencing from 3 March 2014 subject to retirement by rotation and re-election at annual general meetings of the Company in accordance with the articles of association of the Company.
